Activity: Standup Meeting

Respect your team members and give them your **full** attention by putting your laptops and phones away, **stand up**, and share your answers to these three questions with your group.

1. What did I work on yesterday (or the last time my group met)?
2. What am I working on today?
3. What issues are blocking me?

Time limit: 5 minutes (Standup meeting should be short!)

Review: Sprint Planning

A collaborative process where the team defines the sprint goal, selects backlog items to work on, and creates a plan for how to accomplish the work during the sprint.

Your team must answer two questions:

1. What work can get done in this sprint?
2. How will the chosen work get done?

Gotcha: Once planning is complete, the sprint plan is locked. No new work can be added to the sprint until the next planning session.
